Lunchtime arrangements	In the last meeting there were requests for good table manners to be recognised. Mr. Luck explained that those selected would have afternoon tea with Mrs. Wilcox towards the end of a term. It was agreed that this would be welcome.
Early maths information meeting Maths at home	Parents were happy with the Early Maths information meeting. It was agreed that this event would be run again (alongside the Early Reading meeting) one evening in the Spring term to accommodate those parents with work commitments during the day.
Christmas Plays	There was lots of praise for the Christmas plays. It was agreed that they were made more accessible in Key Stage 2 with the plays being performed on two separate days. The performance of the play in church by Reception was enjoyed by those who attended.
Path from car park to school	Discussions were held regarding the path leading from Whithern Park to Churchgate. Mr. Luck explained that the school have been in contact with the council about improving the path which has deteriorated due to the weather. Parents are keen for this to be improved and will be letting the council know their feelings on this matter.
Events in the Spring term	Parents would like to come in to school to see their how their child is learning. It was discussed and agreed that in the Spring term they would be invited in to see a maths lesson to enable them to further support their child's learning at home. Mr. Luck will talk to teaching staff and arrange for this to happen.
