

SCHOOL AT HOME EXPECTATIONS

This guidance is designed to support families when pupils are unable to attend school due to Covid 19 infection control measures. Please let the school office know via email at admin@dewhurst.herts.sch.uk or by telephone during school office hours of any concerns regarding COVID 19 infection with your family bubble.

To ensure the children's learning is meaningful and that they are able to re-join class without having missed any of the learning which has taken place in their classroom, teachers will set work which is directly linked to current class learning.

<p>Suspected Covid or contact with confirmed Covid case- awaiting test results.</p> <p>Day One absent from school</p>	<p>As soon as possible your child's class teacher will be in touch via DOJO or parent email. Read your school book and ask your child questions about the text.</p>
<p>Individual pupil confirmed case and period of self-isolation 1-14 days Year 1-6</p>	<p>Your child's class teacher will set work each day or each week depending on length of isolation via DOJO. All lesson links, notes and activities will be sent via Dojo.</p> <p>Maths taught using the White Rose learning platform.</p> <p>https://whiterosemaths.com/</p> <p>English, Science and other appropriate subjects will be taught using a mixture of familiar learning platforms and PowerPoint clips. Teachers may also use the Oak National Academy to support delivery of some lessons.</p> <p>https://www.thenational.academy/</p> <p>Teachers will provide learning and activities which as best they can mirror that happening in class.</p>	<p>Use your SCHOOL AT HOME exercise books. All pupils from Yr1-6 have been issued with these in preparation for any period of self-isolation or lockdown.</p> <p>You do not need to print activity sheets unless you wish to. Use the exercise books to record work.</p> <p>Continue to photograph and video examples work and pupil reading as necessary and add it your child's Dojo account for the class teacher approve and add to their individual portfolio.</p> <p>After the period of isolation, the class teacher will advise you when to return your SCHOOL AT HOME books to school where they will enjoy looking at, marking as appropriate and give verbal feedback to your child.</p>
<p>Class self-isolating (bubble closed)</p>	<p>Your child's class teacher will set each week to enable parents to plan the best way to approach the learning set for that week. We understand each family's circumstances at home are different and children will complete work at different times of the day due to existing commitments.</p> <p>All lesson videos, links, notes and activities will be sent via Dojo</p> <p>Work will consist of the following (although might be slightly adapted depending curriculum expectations for a particular week-EG; a science or art week focus)</p> <p>English: 4 lesson per week-allowing a day to catch up, for an extended reading or writing</p>	<p>Use your SCHOOL AT HOME exercise books. All pupils from Yr1-6 have been issued with these in preparation for any period of self-isolation or lockdown.</p> <p>You do not need to print activity sheets unless you wish to. Use the exercise books to record work.</p> <p>Continue to photograph and video examples work and pupil reading as necessary and add it your child's Dojo account for the class teacher approve and add to their individual</p>

	<p>or writing in other subject areas Approx. four short videos giving teaching points for each lesson focusing on phonics, vocabulary, punctuation, grammar and spelling. Reception	The EFYS team will set work and activities closely matched to the expectations of the classroom setting allowing you to support your child's development. Please access Dojo for all information on how to watch English, phonics or maths lessons.	Use of photographs and videos to record your child's working or work can be uploaded to Dojo. Any written or drawn tasks can be recorded using the School at Home books.
YEAR 6 Individual pupil confirmed case and period of self-isolation 1-14 days Class self-isolating (bubble closed)	Year Six pupils are beginning guided in the use of Microsoft Teams as a supportive learning platform. TEAMS allows the pupils to be more independent in taking responsibility for completing their work and communicating with the class teacher. Although it is still advised that parents and carers continue to monitor communication with the class teacher via Teams and Dojo. This way of learning will support the children in their transition to Secondary school where platforms such as TEAMS are widely used.	All pupils have their log in details for TEAMS and are taking part on guided session with Ms Ranson and Miss Meale in how to use it safely and effectively as a learning tool.

Please contact your child's class teacher using Dojo if you have any concerns or questions relating to School at Home or any other questions regarding your child's development. Our class teachers and teaching assistants will be closely monitoring the pupils work as it appears on Dojo or via other platforms and are ready to support you.
