Some reminders...

School Dinners -order before 8am

Yr1-6 must select their meal choices on the **School Gateway App**. Years 3,4,5,6 must ensure they are in credit to enable selection. If your child is poorly and absent from school you must cancel the order as the meal will be made and payment will be taken. Reception pupils will not be taking school meals this week but we will be setting this up with parents soon.

School Dinners

Yr1-6 must select their meal choices on the **School Gateway App before 8am.** This is the cut off time and amendments must be made before this time if your child is absent from school please remember to cancel the lunch order otherwise the meal will be prepared and you will be charged.

Free School Meals

We are encouraging all families to check whether they are entitled to benefit related free school meals. Please use this link to check:

You should do this even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and currently receives universal free school meals as if eligible, your child will be able to access the additional provision as detailed in our Pupil Premium plan such as additional resources, support in the classroom and uniform. If you're eligible for free school meals you can also get vouchers from your school for the holidays. Other help may be available via the Household Support Fund.

Communication- Dojo and E-mail

We have put Teachers and Teaching Assistants into teams on Dojo to ensure communication is shared and notices are seen by the relevant member of staff.

Dojo is checked just before children enter school for any messages from parents and again at the end of the school day. So, if you have a message about collection of a pupil, please inform staff in this way. We do not use Dojo when school is closed, messages that are sent later in the evening are picked up the following morning.

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
