Dojo; Please note that teachers will only check Dojo before school briefly and at the end of the school day to see if any changes are there for home time. They don't always check it throughout the day whilst teaching. If your child is isolating with Covid please request remote learning on Dojo but send the confirmation of the result to admin so they can authorise the register.

New reading provision KS 1 and reading intervention in KS 2

Last week children who follow our Read Write Inc phonics programme brought home an additional reading book. Unlike the books they bring home at the moment, these books are completely 'decodable' and will therefore only contain sounds that your child has learned in their phonics lessons, making it easier for them to read independently. This will boost both their confidence and fluency. The new 'Book Bag books' should be treated as reading homework and should be read several times throughout the week before being returned every Thursday to be changed. All other reading books should continue to be read, recorded on the GoRead app and changed as normal and will run alongside the Book Bag Books.

Mrs Davis has made a video which can be found on school dojo explaining how the new books will work and how you can best support your child with their reading. Please take a few minutes to watch the video and contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions.
