
Library –Every Monday after school 3.20-3.45 The library door is the first door as you go round to the playground from the fitness equipment.

Reception's Family Assembly

We look forward to our Reception's first family assembly. We recommend that if you have younger siblings you try to arrange childcare. However, we understand this may be difficult, so we ask that if you do attend with younger siblings it is usually easier to sit at the back for a quick escape if they are finding listening difficult.

Reading At Home

In Reception and Key Stage 1 we teach children to read using our synthetic phonics programme 'Read Write Inc'. We systematically teach the sounds using the RWI core story books with red sight words and speed sounds in. We then send home the corresponding book or flashcards which will allow your child the opportunity to consolidate their learning and accelerate progress. This book should be prioritised and should be read lots of times to ensure your child becomes fluent when reading. How can we support reading at home? <https://youtu.be/VGsqPohuALo>
